ORDINANCE NO. 115

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CALIENTE, STATE OF NEVADA, ADOPTING THE UNIFORM PLUMBING CODE, NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE AND THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE, BUILDING DEPARTMENT FEES AND RULES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING THERETO.

BE IT ENACTED that all Building Ordinances of the City of Caliente, Nevada, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 1: PLUMBING CODE.

A. ADOPTION

(1) The Uniform Plumbing Code, in its latest edition, is hereby adopted and designated as the Plumbing Code of The City of Caliente, State of Nevada.

B. SCOPE

- (1) All plumbing installations and all materials, fixtures, appliances and appurtenances furnished for the installation or sale or distributed for use in or on any building, structure or premises, as well as the practices related thereto within the boundaries of the City of Caliente, State of Nevada, shall conform to the requirements of this Ordinance.
- (2) New buildings and structures or other work, either above or below the surface of the earth and buildings and structures including prefabricated buildings, moved into or within the incorporated areas of the City of Caliente, Nevada shall conform to the requirements of this Ordinance.
- (3) Additions, alterations, replacement and repairs shall comply with the provisions of this Ordinance. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as to requiring any existing portion of the plumbing system, regulated by this Ordinance, to be altered, changed or removed, if such work was installed in accordance with the plumbing code in effect at the time of installation or sub-

condition.

(4) This section shall not apply to public utilities operating under statutory authority, power districts of utilities belonging to a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, authorized and operating under such capacity.

C. PERMITS REQUIRED

- (1) It is unlawful for any person to commence to install, erect or construct any plumbing, plumbing systems, fixtures or apparatus in any new building, new section of existing building or new structure without first obtaining a permit from the Caliente Building Department. A separate permit shall be obtained for each separate structure. Emergency work for the protection of health or property shall have a permit obtained therefore within forty-eight (48) hours of doing said work, holidays excluded.
 - D. WORK EXEMPTED FROM PERMIT REQUIREMENT
- (1) No permit shall be required in the case of any repair work or replacement of any existing plumbing which does not require the rearrangement of valves, pipes or fixtures:
 - a. replacement of broken, leaky or faulty fixtures
 - b. the repair of leaks by the replacement of short sections of pipe
 - c. replacement or repair of any water heating or treating equipment
 - d. cleaning of stoppage
- (2) Exemption from the permit requirements of this
 Ordinance shall not be deemed to grant authorization for any work
 to be done in any way in violation of this Ordinance and the
 Uniform Plumbing Code.
 - E. FEES
 - (1) Inspection and permit fees shall be adopted by resolu-

in the office of the City of Caliente Building Department and the office of the City Clerk. It shall be unlawful to pay or receive any fees or renumeration not provided for by resolution of the City Council.

F. ENFORCEMENT

(1) The City of Caliente Building Department shall enforce the rules and regulations set out in this section and the Uniform Plumbing Code.

SECTION 2: ELECTRICAL CODE

A. ADOPTION

(1) The National Electrical Code, in its latest edition, as recommended by the National Fire Protection Association, together with all tables of contents, definitions, articles, tables, indexes and appendices, and the same is hereby adopted and designated as the Electrical Code of the City of Caliente, State of Nevada, and is hereby made a part of this Ordinance, the same as if it were fully set forth herein.

B. SCOPE

- (1) No alterations or additions shall be made in existing wiring, nor shall any wiring be installed or done for the placing of any light, power or heating devices, or any apparatus which generates, transmits, transforms or utilizes any electricity nor shall any alterations be made to any wiring system without complying with this Ordinance and the National Electrical Code.
- (2) Additions, alterations, replacement and repair as described herein shall comply with the provisions of this Ordinance. Nothing contained in this Ordinance shall be construed as requiring any existing portion of the electrical system, regulated by this Ordinance, to be altered, changed or removed, if such work was installed in accordance with the

- (3) Except as otherwise herein provided, all electrical wiring installations or electrical fixtures, apparatus or appliances for furnishing light, heat and/or power introduced into or placed in or on any building or structure within the incorporated limits of Caliente, shall be in conformity with the rules and requirements of the National Electrical Code and this Ordinance and all fittings and material used in such installation must be sanctioned in the list of electrical fittings, published by the Underwriter's Laboratories.
- (4) This section shall not apply to agencies of government, power districts or power companies and telephone companies operating under government franchise.

C. PERMITS REQUIRED

- (1) It is unlawful for any person to commence to install, erect, alter or construct any electrical apparatus, light, power or heating apapratus which generates, transmits, transforms or utilizes any electricity in any new building or new structure, without first obtaining a permit for construction and inspection therefore from the Caliente Building Department. A separate permit for each separate building or structure shall be obtained. Emergency work for the protection of health or property shall have a permit obtained therefore within forty-eight (48) hours of doing said work, holidays excluded.
- (2) Each application for a permit to install electrical wiring must have attached thereto, a drawing showing the electrical layout including the wiring and apparatus. The drawing must include load calculations and voltage drops in accordance with Article 215-6 of the National Electrical Code.
- (3) During the course of work and upon completion of the installation of any electrical wiring, fixtures, appliances or apparatus in or on any new building or new structure as defined

son doing the work, to notify the City Building Department for required inspections. The Building Department shall cause to be inspected the same, and upon completion, if approved, issue a Certificate of Occupancy or Certificate of Structural Compliance.

(4) It shall be unlawful for any person or utility company to turn on or connect the current with such installation mentioned in paragraph (6), until a Certificate of Occupancy or Structural Compliance has been issued.

D. ENFORCEMENT

(1) The Caliente City Building Department shall enforce the rules and regulations of this section of this Ordinance.

E. FEES

(1) Inspection and permit fees shall be adopted by resolution of the City Council of Caliente and be on file in the office of the Building Department and in the office of the City Clerk.

It shall be unlawful to pay or receive any fee or renumeration not provided for by resolution of the City Council.

SECTION 3: UNIFORM BUILDING CODE

A. ADOPTION

(1) The Uniform Building Code (and Uniform Building Code Appendix), in its latest edition, and the Uniform Building Code Standards, in its latest edition, both published by the International Conference of Building Officials, Whittier, California, and any revisions thereof, is hereby adopted as the Building Code of Caliente, Nevada, and is designated as the code for regulating the erection, construction, enlargement, alteration, moving, removal, conversion, use, height, area and maintenance of all buildings and/or structures within the incorporated areas of the City of Caliente, State of Nevada.

B. CONFLICT WITH ZONING

provisions of existing zoning and planning Ordinances relating to location of buildings and/or structures and use of property. The said Ordinances shall prevail in all matters in which there may develop a conflict between them and the Building Code.

C. PERMITS REQUIRED

- (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to commence to erect, construct, enlarge, alter, move, improve or convert any building or structure regulated by this Ordinance, except as specified in Subsection (D) of this exception, or cause same to be done without first obtaining a separate permit for each separate structure from the Caliente Building Department.
 - D. WORK EXEMPTED FROM PERMITS
- (1) One-story detached accessory buildings, provided the projected roof area does not exceed 120 square feet.
 - (2) Fences and walls not over 6 feet high.
- (3) Retaining walls which are not over 4 feet high, measured from the bottom of the footing to the top of the wall.
- (4) Interior repair and remodeling provided such work does not involve the removal or replacement of load-bearing walls and/or structural sections of floors and ceilings.
- (5) Repair or replacement of roofing materials such as vapor barriers, finish roofing, shingles, etc., provided the work does not involve the replacement of any structural portion of the roof such as the replacement and rafters or trusses.
 - (6) Repair, replacement or installation of exterior siding
- (7) Exemption from the permit requirements of this Ordinance shall not be deemed as granting authorization for any work to be done in any manner in violation of the provisions of this Ordinance and the Uniform Building Codes.

E. MOVED BUILDINGS

(1) Buildings or structures moved into or within the City

for new buildings or structures. Moved buildings shall include mobile homes as defined by Nevada Revised Statutes, Chapter 489.120, for the purpose of this Ordinance.

- (2) No building or structure shall be moved or relocated unless a permit is first obtained from the Caliente City Building Department.
- (3) No permit shall be issued to relocate any building if it reasonably appears that after such relocation, the building would not be in compliance with this Ordinance, or if it appears that the proposed site would be contradictory to existing zoning and planning Ordinances.
- (4) A bond shall be posted prior to the issuance of a permit to move or relocate a building, with the Caliente Building Department. Said bond shall name the owner of the proposed location of the building as principal and a surety company authorized to do buisness in this State, as surety. The bond, which shall be in form joint and several, shall name the City as obligee, and shall be in an amount equal to the cost, plus twenty-five percent (25%) of the work required to be done in order for the building to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance. In lieu of bond, cash may be posted.
- (5) Bond requirements may be waived by the City Council, which if it reasonably appears that the provisions of this Ordinance can be met without bond.
- (6) If there is default in performance of conditions, those in default will be given written notice of default by mailing said notice to the owner at his address indicated on the bond. The notice shall include those specifics which must be cured and a reasonable amount of time in which to cure them. If at the end of said reasonable time, and in no event less than thirty (30) days, said defects are not cured, the bond will be forfeited to

(7) In lieu of completing the work as set forth above, the surety shall have the option of demolishing the building or structure and clearing, cleaning and restoring the site. If the surety defaults, then the City Building Department shall have the same option.

(8) Applications for moving a building will not be accepted unless accompanied by a minimum fee of \$25.00, which will be applied to the permit fee but will not be refunded in the instance that the permit is not granted. The minimum fee is used by the Building Department to defray the costs in the initial inspections of the building to be moved and the proposed site on which the building will be located. During this inspection, the inspector will list and make record of the work necessary to bring the building up to the standards of the Codes and Ordinances of the City and the laws of the State. The inspector will then provide an estimate of the work to be done which will then be used for the purchasing of the bond. A copy of the inspection report will be issued within 15 days of the finalization of the estimate.

E. OCCUPANCY

- (1) No newly constructed building or structure shall be occupied before the issuance of a Certificate of Structural Compliance, by the City of Caliente Building Department.
- (2) A temporary Certificate of Occupancy may be issued by the Building Department for the use of a portion or portions of a building or structure prior to the completion of the entire building or structure if said portion or portions meet the requirements of this Ordinance.

F. ENFORCEMENT

(1) The City of Caliente Building Department shall enforce the rules and regulations set out in this Ordinance.
